1. **Delamotte Brut NV, Le Mesnil sur Oger (Grand Cru)** **£54.00**
Situated in the heart of Mesnil sur Oger, the finest Grand Cru Chardonnay vineyards. The 5th oldest House & sister property to Salon the rarest of Champagnes. 125ml glass: **£9.50**
2. **Laurent-Perrier Brut NV, Tours-sur-Marne** **£59.50**
One of the rare family owned house (Nonancourt), Chardonnay makes up 55% of the blend & accounts for the refined, elegant style.
3. **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV, Montagne de Reims** **£76.50**
Intense, Pinot Noir dominated blend. Full bodied yet delightfully fresh.
4. **Bollinger Special Cuvée NV, Ay Vallee de la Marne** **£80.00**
Wonderful Champagne with great depth of flavour and a long finish.
5. **Laurent-Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut NV, Tours-sur-Marne** **£86.50**
Rose Champagne accounts for less than 5% of overall production but L-P have made theirs in to the iconic wine of the region.
6. **Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque 2004, Cote des Blancs** **£132.00**
The 'flower bottle' design evokes the Belle Epoch era of the 1890's. Outstanding fragrance & style.
7. **Dom Perignon 2003, Epernay** **£175.00**
Magnificent cuvee produced by Moet et Chandon. Astonishingly consistent quality.
8. **Salon 1999 Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger** **£300.00**
The rarest wine in Champagne with the 1999 being the 37th vintage.....Dom Perignon produce more in a single vintage than Salon have made in history!

28. **Sancerre 2015 Domaine du Nozay, Central Loire** £45.00
Phillippe de Benoist farms his vineyards organically and produces elegant, restrained wines. This wine has a refined citrus and elderflower fruit intensity.
29. **Condrieu 2011 Domaine Tardieu-Laurent, Northern Rhone, France** £78.00
Viognier is the grape variety here & Condrieu it's historical & finest home. Exotic, orange blossom & white peaches that are held in check by a lovely structure & great balance.
30. **Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Abbaye de Morgeot 2010 Leflaive, Burgundy** £105.00
A wonderfully crafted Chardonnay from a fine Premier Cru. Olivier Leflaive's house specialises in its whites, this is Burgundy at its Zenith.

Fruit driven style with citrus, green apple & riper tropical notes from NZ's north island.

The Gonnet family own top Chateauneuf Estate Font de Michelle & use some younger vine fruit from the estate in this blend. Soft, with damson & red berry fruit.
69. **Chateau La Fleur des Graves 2012, Bordeaux** £37.50
2010 was a magnificent vintage in Bordeaux & this Merlot dominated blend has rich, heady fruit seasoned with some new oak barrels.
64. **Beaujolais Villages La Caves de Croisee 2014/2015 Ferraud** £32.00
A match for many a Cru Beaujolais & blended in part from fruit grown in Fleurie & Brouilly. Juicy red berries & perfect with lamb
70. **Chateauneuf du Pape Reserve 2012 Chateau Beauchene, Southern Rhone** £58.00
A full bodied, boldly flavoured, rich red with warm bramble fruit & a sappy, almost Port like quality from ageing in old oak barrels.
71. **Gevrey Chambertin 2009 Louis Boillot, Burgundy** £78.00
Sourced from a number of small vineyards this is full of mixed red fruit flavours with good weight, concentration & a long finish.
72. **Cote Rotie La Landonne 2001 Rene Rostaing, Northern Rhone, France** £120.00
Hermitage & Cote Rotie compete as the two finest red wine appellations of the Rhone Valley. Cote Rotie is literally the 'roasted hill', a superb, albeit tiny vineyard making Nuanced wines with great perfume & style
73. **Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru 2009 Chateau de la Tour, Burgundy, France** £158.00
With the ever spiralling cost of Grand Cru Burgundy, chateau de la Tour represents something of an insiders wine & a regular critics pick as best wine of the vintage. A short time in a decanter allows the wine to show its full breeding & complexity.

USA

74. **Californio Syrah 2008 Hyde de Villaine, Carneros, California** £85.00
A dual effort from Larry Hyde & Aubert de Villaine of Domaine de la Romanee Conti. Syrah is a very hot grape variety in California at the moment & this shows why with a whopping 93 points from Robert Parker.



Italy

61. **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 'Rocastella' 2015 Villa Bizarri, Marche** £26.50
Medium bodied & packed with morello cherry fruit & the earthy complexity found in the wines from the finest area of Rocastella.
75. **Chianti Classico Terre di Prenzano 2013 Vignamaggio, Tuscany** £37.95
One of Chianti's oldest & finest estates.....the Vignamaggio family commissioned the painting of the Mona Lisa. Medium bodied with a pronounced red berry character typical of Sangiovese.

Spain

76. **PSI 2010 Peter Sisseck, Ribera del Duero, Spain** £55.00
Peter Sisseck is the winemaker behind Pingus which stands alongside Vega Sicilai as Spain's finest wine. He makes PSI from a separate parcel of vines in Ribera with 100% Tempranillo.
77. **Mas Oliveras Tempranillo 2015 Bodegas Roqueta, Catalunya** £23.50
Exceptional value can be found in Spain's lesser known regions. This is ripe, full of red fruits & generous from one of Spain's oldest Bodegas.
65. **Bodegas Zugober Rioja Crianza 2012/2013 Belezos, Spain** £32.00
An exceptional producer based in the high quality Alavesas area of Rioja. Rich fruitcake & dark berry fruit complemented by mellow, cedary oak.

Argentina

66. **Malbec 2014 Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza** £37.00
The Malbec grape is producing some of the finest reds in Argentina. Layers of concentrated, dark cherry & plummy fruit with a creamy richness.

Chile

60. **El Campesino Cabernet / Carmenere 2015, Colchagua** £21.50
A blend of 70% Cabernet topped up with Carmenere & produced organically. This is a real crowd pleaser with generous dark berry fruit.
67. **Vina Mar Reserva Pinot Noir 2015, Casablanca Valley** £28.00
Casablanca's cooler climate is the perfect home for Pinot Noir where it is able to retain all of its inherent complexity. Medium bodied & ideal with lamb dishes.

South Africa
